

Graduation Fee Information

As announced in the student handbook, all seniors are required to pay a graduation fee of \$200.00, which is due by April 28 to Mrs. Helen White, Financial Administrator. The graduation fee covers: academic attire (cap, gown, and hood), flowers, rentals, printing costs, security, and a donation for each church. In addition, this fee includes a copy of the 2010 yearbook, which will be distributed at the All Night Grad party after graduation.

For a student to receive their academic attire and their Graduation tickets, both the academic requirements and the financial obligations (including the graduation fee) must be met. A senior who has not fulfilled all of his/her academic requirements will NOT be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony. All elements of the handbook will be honored through the conferral of the diploma. Any senior who has any financial debts to the school (tuition, transcript fees, Sage account, library fines or any other outstanding account) will NOT be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremonies; no diploma will be given and no transcripts or letters of recommendation will be sent. Additionally, all detentions must be served and all community service and retreat requirements must be completed in order to participate in the commencement exercises. Please make sure that all problems are worked out well before the celebrations, as we all want it to be a carefree, joyous, and memorable time.

Academic attire will be distributed to students on Tuesday, May 4. Please ensure that your student's gown is ironed for both the Baccalaureate Mass and Graduation ceremony.
