Summer Workshops

The transition workshop courses are designed to prepare and help students by refreshing skills that will be beneficial for students to succeed when entering high school. The math and language arts study skills workshops are intended for incoming 9th grade students to prepare for high school academics; however the study skills workshop is open to all students.

The workshop courses are not for credit, but students will receive evaluations from instructors upon request.

Math Workshop

The High School Math workshop is designed to prepare incoming freshman students for their 1st year of high school mathematics. The course would allow for preparation in the areas of orders of operations, decimals, fractions, operations with integers, and word problems. While credit is not awarded for this course, the content will enable each student to proceed with greater confidence at the start of their high school education.

Language Arts/Study Skills Workshop

The Following skills will be reviewed improving spelling by reviewing phonics, reading improvement skills, punctuation essentials, and using pneumonic and other memory devices. Students can also expect to build upon efficient study habits, vocabulary development, sequencing, inferencing, and finding the main idea. Other areas that will be developed in the workshop are note taking skills, outlining, development of a thesis, writing skills, and research skills. While credit is not awarded for this course, students taking part in this workshop can expect for a full offering of all the skills needed for achievement and development of retention skills while in high school

Attendance

Good attendance contributes directly to academic success; therefore, students are expected to attend all classes every day. This is essential as it keeps the student up to speed on what is being taught and does not delay the instructor with a student that is behind in the material. If a student needs to be absent, they should pre-arrange with the instructor and prepare to stay caught up on the content.

Textbooks/Supplies

Any items needed before workshops meet will be indicated by summer school coordinator. Once students begin their workshop, teachers will indicate what supplies are needed. Paper, pen, and pencil are always good to have the first day regardless!

Tuition

- If a student decides he/she is unable to attend class before class begins the tuition *less \$50.00 will be refunded*
- Students who withdraw from school within two class days will have *one-half of the tuition refunded*.
- Students who withdraw from school after two class days are responsible for *full payment of tuition*.

On Campus

All students should enter campus from the lower parking lot through the entrance atop of the circle drive/drop-off (there is a sign that says “*student entrance*”). Student entrance will be towards the left nearest the chapel, the summer school staff will be onsite to open the door and direct any students that cannot find their classroom. When students are on campus they are permitted to bring a snack with them.

Students are not to leave the ground floor where all summer classes will be held without permission. In between workshops if students are signed up for both, students should wait only in the cafeteria, where snacks and drinks may be purchased from the vending machines.
