



### **Web Page Development**

This course presents an overview of the Internet, World Wide Web, and hypertext document and introduces the student to web page design and development using web page design software (Dreamweaver CS4) as well as limited Hypertext Markup Language (HTML). The student will learn how to use correct file and folder structure, text formatting and alignment, heading tags, anchors, links to and from additional pages and sites, backgrounds, graphics and image maps, tables, forms, layers, frames, styles, and style sheets in creating both assigned practice and independently designed web sites. Web Page Development is computer sciences credit course (.50 computer science credit) that will satisfy the graduation requirement needed by all students attending Bishop Ireton.
